

## **Public Notice of Work**

**To: Residents of St. Clair Shores  
City of St. Clair Shores  
Macomb County**

The City of St. Clair Shores has contracted Environmental Consulting & Technology (ECT) to perform an outfall survey of the Lake St. Clair Shoreline and associated canals to identify, photograph, and sample outfalls discharging to the lake. Two ECT staff will be working along the shoreline by boat or by wading along the shoreline to collect the information necessary to complete the outfall survey. Field personnel will confine their actions to the lake and its immediate shoreline.

In addition ECT staff will also be performing a survey of city owned enclosed storm sewers throughout various locations in the city. The work involves locating, opening and inspecting catch basins and manholes. Two ECT staff will be working throughout the city.

Both the inland and shoreline surveys are expected to commence in mid-April 2007 and last though out the fall. Field crews will be conducting the work between the hours of 7:00 am and 4:00 pm Monday through Friday.

This work is being performed in order to comply with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit as required by the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality. The NPDES program is intended to control direct discharge into the surface waters of the state by imposing effluent limits and other conditions necessary to meet state and federal requirements
