

“PCB Investigation Update”...

We bring you the latest developments in the ongoing investigation and elimination of the PCBs found in the 10 Mile Drainage District and Lange and Revere canals.

On July 18 th, Environmental Protection Agency representative Jeff Kimble reported to the City that the results from “test sets” of the Geo-probe samples taken from the 10 Mile Drainage District had been validated. Next week, officials from the EPA and the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) will meet to discuss the results and map out a course of action.

Once a remedial plan is identified, the City will hold a town hall meeting to discuss the course of action and timelines with concerned residents. Watch SCSTV for the location of the public meeting, date and time.

Please, remember that data already collected to date suggests that the PCBs are not coming into contact with the general public and do not involve a public health threat.
