

PCB INVESTIGATION UPDATE for 6/30/2006:

Progress continues on the PCB Cleanup efforts. The EPA reports that 95% of the low level PCBs have been removed from residential and commercial properties between Bon Brae and Bon Heur. Weather permitting, the remainder of the soil removal and restoration will be completed the first week in July.

Next, the 10 Mile Drain pipe will be inspected for debris, roots, damage and any other anomalies. The pipe will then be jet-cleaned thoroughly and prepared for installation of the cured-in-place liner.

The EPA has also completed the Work Plan for the Phase II PCB Cleanup. A copy is available for resident's review in the Public Library at 11 Mile and Jefferson or online at www.scsmi.net.
