ALL WORK MUST BE DONE WITHIN THE LEGAL PROPERTY LINES OF THE HOMEOWNER. ALL WORK MUST HAVE THE PROPER PERMITS FROM LOCAL AND FEDERAL GOVERNMENT PRIOR TO WORK COMMENCING.**

A building permit must be obtained from the City of St. Clair Shores by your Marine Contractor before work can commence. Immediately upon completion, applicant shall notify the Community Development Department, calling for an inspection to insure compliance with installation as approved.

REQUIRED DEPARTMENT OF ARMY, CORP OF ENGINEERS AND DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES PERMITS MUST BE OBTAINED BEFORE ANY WORK IS STARTED.

All work covered by this application must be completed within one (1) year from date of Board approval.

Dear City of St. Clair Shores Waterfront Resident:

It has been brought to the attention of the Administration of the City of St. Clair Shores that many of our waterfront property owners are unaware of the established ordinances which affect them as waterfront property owners. These particular ordinances were carefully adopted to maintain the beauty and the preservation of the shoreline, to protect the investment of your property, and to enhance your pleasure and benefits of living on the water.

These special ordinances govern any construction on or adjacent to the water's edge, such as seawalls, boat hoists, catwalks, and docks. They also concern the mooring and storage of boats and other watercraft; furthermore, these ordinances deal with the prevention of erosion and the maintenance of seawalls. You are encouraged to make yourself aware of the Community Development Department telephone number of (586) 447-3340. They will explain to you the procedure for obtaining building permits, applicable fees, public hearings (if necessary), and any other information you may need.

Illegal construction, prohibited mooring of boats and watercraft, rental of boat spaces to non-occupants, etc., are problems which adversely affect all waterfront residents to make this wonderful and unique boating mecca even better.
