

March 8, 2023 Beautification Meeting Minutes

February 8, 2023 minutes were read and approved.

Treasurer's Report: Diana Lince said there was no updated report available.

New Business: The lights at the Masonic entrance sign should be installed soon. If they are acceptable, the lights at Donaldson and the Milk River will also be updated.

Lillian Claycomb said there will be changes made to the city website.

The sign at the city golf course will be updated this year.

The flowerpot located at Greenwood Elementary will be moved to the South Lake administration building. The pot at Harmon Elementary will be moved to the new pier at Blossom Heath.

Diana Lince reported Denise Pecherski will germinate tomato plants to pass out at the next Farmer's Market. Lynn Brown will germinate other plants to pass out at the market.

Irrigation problems from 2022 were discussed. These issues will hopefully be addressed this year.

The official opening of the new pier at Blossom Heath will take place on May 4, 2023. Lillian Claycomb would like to see the pots located at the pier planted before this event.

Lillian Claycomb also reported the city will make a decision about the consequences for businesses and residents who have invasive plants in their landscaping.

Lillian also said she attended the Waterfront Advisory Committee meeting.

Methods to remove geese from around the city were discussed.

Roundtable: Michelle Hayden said she is going to update her bed at the Rotary sign due to the perennials being overgrown.
