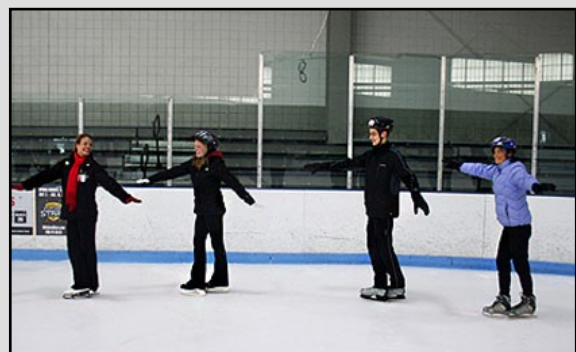

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- Instructions and badge follows the regulations of Learn to Skate USA
- Proper fitting skates are required – **no double blades!**
- Helmet, mittens / gloves are required for children 6 and under. Helmet with a cage is *highly* recommended
- Schedule is subject to change
- Rental Skates are available for \$20 per session.

Registration Policy:

- Make checks payable to the City of St. Clair Shores.
- Annual basic skills membership fee must be paid in order to participate for lessons.
- A \$17.25 membership can be purchased online at www.LearnToSkateUSA.com
- Everyone must be registered before the session starts.

Refund and Transfer Policy:

- Refunds must be *requested and approved* prior to the second class
- No refunds will be given after the second class. A \$5 processing fee will be charged per refund.

Make-up Policy:

- Skaters are able to make up one class per session and you must email the Director or fill out a make-up slip at least 24 hours in advance.
